

The E-Government Act (Public Law 107-347) was signed into law by President Bush in December 2002. Information security is recognized as critical to the economy and national security of the United States. “Federal Information Security Management Act” (FISMA) requires each federal system to undergo a certification and accreditation process that certifies federal systems have implemented the minimum security controls and processes to protect the confidentiality, integrity and availability of government data.

Lincoln Peak provides the PopMedNet/Distributed Network Services Query Tool to several collaborating institutions conducting healthcare research and providing data for research. Lincoln Peak partners with Carpathia Hosting to provide secure, robust, high performance infrastructure and application services.
